Chief Complaint: Newborn Visit. Establishing Care.

History of Present Illness:

TR is a 4d male born to G1P1 mother at 39w6d by NSVD. Received HepB vaccination at birth. Mother and TR are both O+. Mother denies complications of pregnancy. The postpartum period was uncomplicated. TR and mother were discharged after 2 days. Parents state that TR is doing well. TR is being breastfed and receiving supplemental Enfamil formula (approximately 10-15cc). He is feeding hourly. He is stooling 1-3x/day with yellow-liquid consistency. He is voiding 6-7x/day. TR has nearly regained his birth weight. He is sleeping in approximately ½ hour to 1 hour increments.

Birth History: Born to G1P1 mother at 39w6d by NSVD at NYPQ. Birth Weight: . APGAR: . Complications: None. # of Days in Hospital: 2 days.

Development: Suckles, burps. Focuses briefly on parents face.

Immunizations: HepB at birth. UTD.

Diet/Nutrition: Breastfeeding hourly. Enfamil formula to supplement feeds (10-15cc).

Allergies: NKDA

Social History: Lives with mother and father in house. Mother and father are nonsmokers.

Family History: Denies

Review of Systems:

General: Admits weight gain. Denies fever, anorexia, weight loss, change in activity level

Neuro: Denies HA, trauma, LOC, seizure activity, developmental delays

HEENT: Denies change in vision, hearing, photo/phonophobia, neck pain, runny nose, ear pain, sore throat.

CV: Denies shortness of breath, sweating, color changes with feeding, chest pain, palpitations, recent history of murmur, fainting, or dizziness with activity

Respiratory: Denies cough, wheezing, shortness of breath (triggers)

GI: Denies nausea, vomiting (bloody/bilious), diarrhea, constipation, hematemesis, hematochezia, or melena; describe stooling habits

GU: Denies dysuria, frequency, urgency, hematuria

Endo: Denies polyuria/polydipsia, heat/cold intolerance, growth pattern abnormalities

MS: Denies myalgias, arthralgias, trauma, limp, weakness

Skin: Denies rashes, bruising, petechiae

Physical Exam:

Vital Signs:

BP: 72/44

Pulse: 164bpm

RR: 36 breaths/min

Temp: 37.5C

SpO2: 100%RA

Ht: 20.5 inches

Wt: 4.37 kg

General Survey: Alert, strong cry, consolable.

Skin: No petechiae, masses, lesions. No jaundice, cyanosis, mottling. No rashes.

Hair: Average quantity and distribution.

Nails: Capillary refill <2s throughout.

Head: NC/AT. A/P Fontanelles soft. Non-tender to palpation throughout. No plagiocephaly.

Eyes: Red reflex present bilaterally.

Ears: External ear with no masses, lesions. *TM's?*

Nose: Nares patent. No nasal flaring. Mucosa pink.

Throat: Mucosa pink. Uvula midline.

Cardiovascular: Regular rate and rhythm. S1 and S2. No murmurs, gallops, rubs.

Chest and Pulmonary: Symmetrical rise and fall of chest wall. No labored breathing, accessory muscle use. Clear to auscultation bilaterally.

Abdomen: Nondistended. BS +. Soft, non-tender. *masses negative*

Neuro: Moro reflex, Rooting Reflex, Sucking Reflex present

Genital - *circ? testis ✓*
Assessment/Plan: *Ext - neg or tolaric = lengthy no repair club.*
TR is a 4d male born to G1P1 mother at 39w6d by NSVD here for Newborn Visit and Establishing Care.

#Healthy 4d Male

- Advised parents that the newborn is "cluster feeding" at this time, but feeds will begin to space out to a more consistent q2-3h over the next few weeks
- Safe sleep education provided

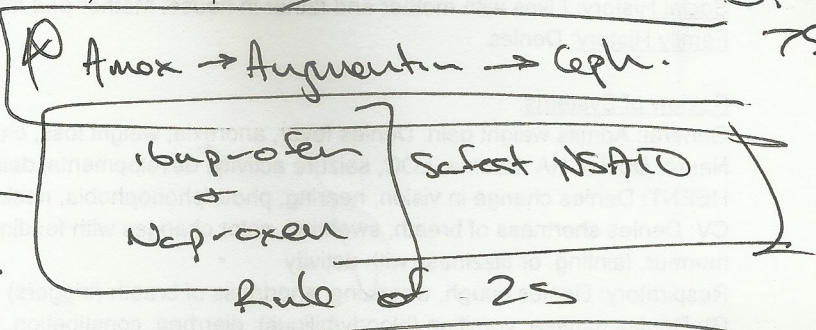
#FEN
